



## Sample Bequest Language

A gift to Delaware Valley University in your will or revocable trust proclaims your confidence that we will continue to serve our mission and make a difference in the lives of future generations. A bequest:

- Is easy to arrange.
- Will not alter your current lifestyle in any way.
- Can be easily modified to address your changing needs.

### Residual Bequest Language

A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

*I give and devise to Delaware Valley University, Tax I.D. #23-1352665, an independent, comprehensive four-year residential institution in Doylestown, Pennsylvania, all (or state a percentage) of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).*

### Specific Bequest Language

Naming DelVal as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate is easy:

*“I hereby give the residue (or \_\_\_\_\_ percent of the residue) of my estate to Delaware Valley University, Tax I.D. #23-1352665, an independent, comprehensive four-year residential institution in Doylestown, Pennsylvania, to further the objectives and purposes of the University (or specify the School, Division or Department at DelVal).”*

### Contingent Bequest Language

DelVal can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:

*If (insert name) is not living at the time of my demise, I give and devise to Delaware Valley University, Tax I.D. #23-1352665, an independent, comprehensive four-year residential institution in Doylestown, Pennsylvania, the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (or all or a percentage of the residue of my estate) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific fund or program).*
